EXAMPLES OF ARBITRAL PROCEEDINGS - ACTING AS COUNSEL

- Representation of a company providing assembly, installation, and commissioning services for electrical systems in Wind Farms, against the company responsible for implementing the project, in an arbitration proceeding under the CAM-CCBC rules, involving reimbursement for costs and losses incurred.
- Representation of a transportation company in arbitration proceedings under the CIESP rules, discussing the validity and enforceability of obligations set forth in business, strategic, and financial consulting agreements.

EXAMPLES OF NATIONAL COURTS PROCEEDINGS - ACTING AS COUNSEL

- Representation in a judicial proceeding for the advance taking of evidence, involving a discussion on jurisdiction for the production of evidence — whether the arbitral tribunal or the state court — when there is no urgency in the request for document production.

EXAMPLES OF ARBITRAL PROCEEDINGS – ACTING AS SECRETARY OF THE ARBITRAL TRIBUNAL

- Acting as secretary of the arbitral tribunal in proceedings under the CIESP rules, in which an insurance company seeks compensation for the amounts incurred from the alleged perpetrator of the damage
- Acting as secretary of the arbitral tribunal in proceedings under the CIESP rules initiated by a construction company that, after completion of a real estate development, seeks payment for the services it considers to be due and fully rendered.
- Acting as secretary of the arbitral tribunal in proceedings under the CAM-CCBC rules involving termination of a contract for the formation of a company and consortium operating in the water supply and sewage collection sector, with compensation for direct and indirect losses.
- Acting as secretary to the sole arbitrator in proceedings under the CAM-CCBC rules involving compliance with obligations related to investment advisory contracts.
